A proposal to amend
Section 2 of Article IV of the State Constitution to
require the Lieutenant Governor to serve as the head
of a department as assigned by the Governor.

Be It Proposed by the Constitution Revision Commission of
Florida:

Section 2 of Article IV of the State Constitution is
amended to read:

ARTICLE IV
EXECUTIVE

SECTION 2. Lieutenant governor.—

There shall be a lieutenant governor, who shall:

(a) As assigned by the governor, serve as the head of any
department of which the head is a secretary appointed by the
governor, without senate confirmation and notwithstanding any
qualifications for appointment as secretary of the department;
and

(b) Perform such duties pertaining to the office of
governor as shall be assigned by the governor, except when
otherwise provided by law, and such other duties as may be
prescribed by law.
